Biography:

Dragana S. Krstic was born in Pirot, Serbia. She received the BSc, MSc and PhD degrees in electrical engineering from Department of Telecommunications, Faculty of Electronic Engineering, University of Nis, Serbia, in 1990, 1998 and 2006, respectively. Her field of interest includes Wireless and Mobile Telecommunication Systems, Multi-hop Relay Systems, Fading Channels Modeling, etc.

She works at the University of Nis, Faculty of Electronic Engineering since 1990. During this period she was engaged in teaching of several courses. She participated in several projects which are supported by Serbian Ministry of Science and has led some international projects. She now holds the title of Scientific Associate.

Dr Dragana Krstic has over 370 published references, written or co-authored scientific papers and other scientific results. From this issue more than 70 papers are published in journals, 175 at the international symposia and conferences, about thirty at national conferences. She had more than thirty Plenary and Keynote lectures, Panels and Tutorials by invitation at international conferences and some faculties.

She is Associate Editor or member of Editorial Advisory Board/ Editorial Board or Guest Editor of several journals, as well as Lead Guest Editor of the Special Issues. Likewise, she serves as a reviewer for highly-respected journals with Impact factor. Also, she has reviewed many papers in other prominent journals.

She is/ was the member of technical program committees and international scientific committees of around 200 scientific conferences and beside these, reviewer of the papers for the near 200 other conferences.

As an editor, or one of the editors, she has edited a dozen proceedings from international conferences. She is IARIA Fellow.
