He was a visiting professor at the International College of NIDA in Bangkok, Thailand, the Turkish-German University in Istanbul, Turkey, and Macquarie University in Sydney, Australia.

His current research focuses on the disruptive impact of AI on media, interactive media innovations, technology acceptance research, and mobile HCI. Professor Böhm is the author of more than 90 articles and a committee/editorial board member of several academic conferences and journals.
